**Welcome kindergarten parent(s):**

**As your child enters the Wayland Public Schools, there are a few health-related items necessary for the start of school. According to the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) regulations, your child may not enter kindergarten without documentation by your health care provider of their 5-year physical exam and required immunizations. For your convenience we are listing the health items necessary to start kindergarten in the September 2011 school year.**

- 2 doses of MMR vaccine
- 2 doses of Varicella vaccine
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine
- 5 doses of Dtap/DTP vaccine
- 4 doses of Polio vaccine
  
- Age 5 Physical Exam, which includes your child's comprehensive vision testing results.

Please submit this information to the Loker School office, attention School Nurse, at your earliest convenience.

If your child has any medical concern, which may include a "life threatening" allergy that will require an Epi-Pen, please contact the school nurse to discuss.
